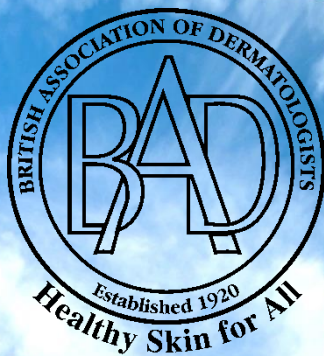

Welcome



Please review this document and don't forget to take advantage of the early bird registration rates!!

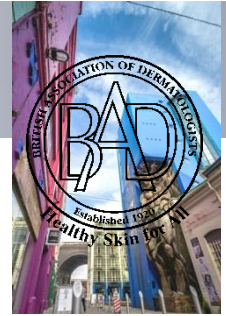
