**Consultation on Ambulight Photodynamic Therapy
for the Treatment of Non-melanoma Skin Cancer**

The Therapy and Guidelines Sub-Committee of the British Association of Dermatologists has reviewed this consultation document, and agrees with the draft recommendations made by the Medical Technologies Advisory Committee of NICE that the case for adopting the Ambulight PDT for the treatment of non-melanoma skin cancer in the NHS could not, at this stage, be supported over current management. In so doing, the sub-committee feels that the relevant available evidence for clinical effectiveness and resource savings has been taken into account, that there has been reasonable interpretation of the evidence, that the recommendations are sound and a suitable basis for guidance to the NHS, and that there are no relevant equality issues.
