The consensus view of the committee was to support the reclassification of Bazuka extra strength gel 26.0% from P to GSL. Apart from occasional skin irritation it was agreed that there would be no undue risk to the user of this product. It was felt that most people would probably still consult the pharmacist over whether to use the lower or higher strength gel and this would ensure they received the best advice and a check that the diagnosis of warts or verrucas was the correct one.
