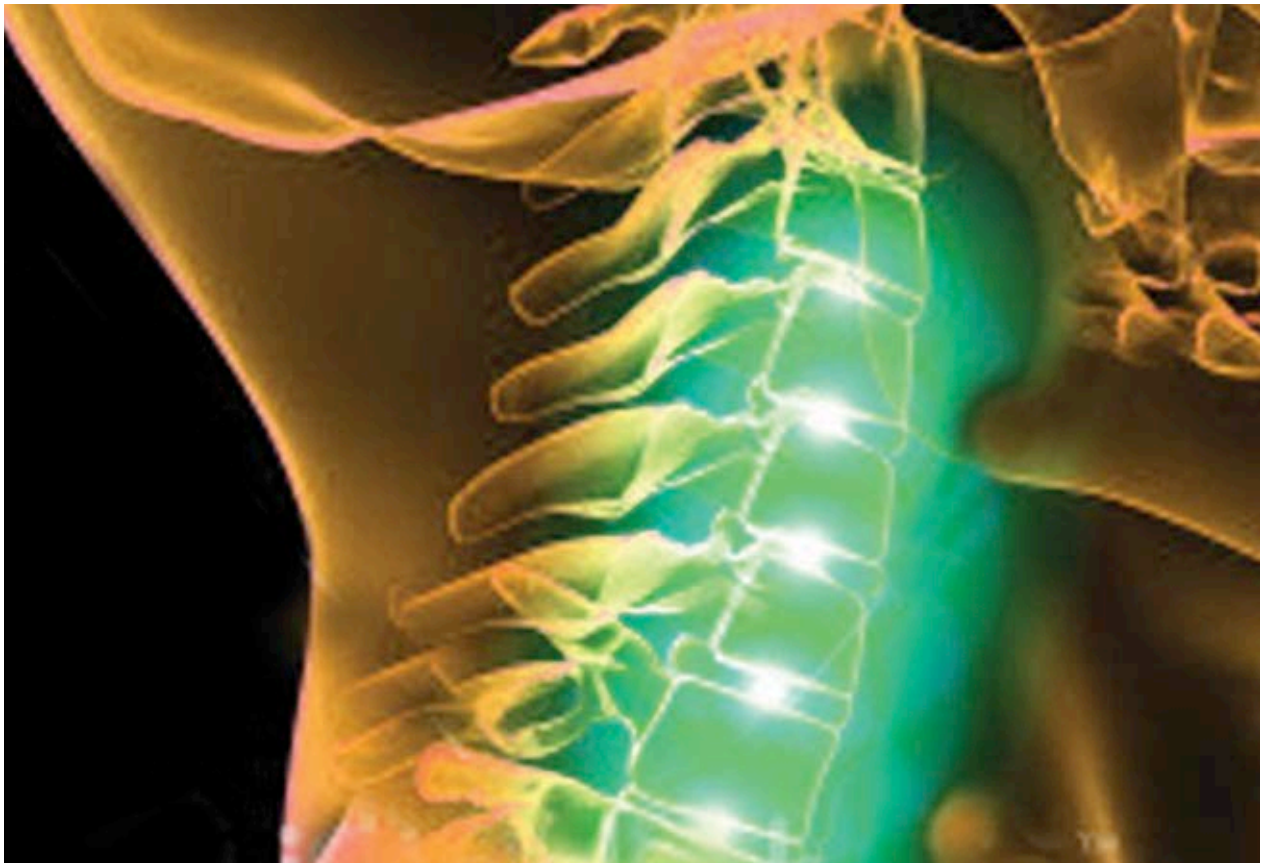

The Eighth Annual Royal Marsden Head and Neck Conference: Upper aerodigestive tract cancer – what does NICE want us to do?

Introduction

Dear Colleagues

This year we have chosen to focus on the recently published NICE guidelines on upper aerodigestive tract cancer. The meeting assembles some of the country's leading experts to critically discuss the evidence base on which the guidelines were developed. The meeting will be of particular interest to maxillofacial, ENT or plastic surgeons with an interest in head and neck oncology, as well as clinical / medical oncologists, radiologists and pathologists. The meeting will be interactive with ample opportunity to discuss the evidence presented.

Conference Aims

This course aims to build on the successes of the last seven years and will explore the issues surrounding the recently published NICE guidelines. The day will consist of presentations from members of the Guideline Committee exploring the evidence and health economic basis for some of the more pertinent upper aerodigestive tract guidelines. Presenters will also discuss their perception of the process of guideline development and how the guidelines have influenced the day-to-day practice of their MDTs. The afternoon will conclude with 'Question Time' which is envisaged to be an opportunity for the audience to explore some of the issues surrounding guideline development and implementation.

- Management of the neck
- Management of early stage oro-pharyngeal and laryngeal tumours
- De-intensification of treatment
